He has taught at both these Schools and also at the University of London (Birkbeck College) and the Loughborough University Business School. He is a Visiting Professor of Electronic Commerce at BEM, the Bordeaux School of Management. He has designed and delivered executive seminars to multinationals and national corporations. He has co-edited two books, “Organizations as Knowledge Systems” with H. Tsoukas, and “Social and Economic Transformation in the Digital Era” with G. Doukidis and N. Pouloudi.
